We now have her ninety-three-year-old father, Gus, comfortable in the Shepherd Lodge retirement home where he is well-fed and well-looked after.

But in this chapter of Gus's life, for us it is not just a case of "putting him in a home." He is still a person; he is still "Dad" and we (particularly Ginny) are still fully involved in his life – visiting him almost every day, taking care of ongoing visits to doctors, dentists, etc., and sitting with him watching his beloved baseball and ice hockey when they are in season.

The other day I said to him, "Dad, we do not come to visit you because we think you want us to come; we visit you because WE want to see you." That brought a wonderful big smile to Dad's face.

If our reason for visiting our aging parents is out of obligation or a sense of duty, then something is wrong with our motivation. Christ died for us not because He needed to, but because He WANTED to. THAT is true unconditional love. We visit Dad because we love him.

Especially at times like this we remind ourselves that ‘nothing comes as a surprise to God.’ And the Lord has reminded us that although our circumstances may change, HE NEVER CHANGES. He is STILL, and always will be, Jehovah Jireh - our provider; and we must keep our eyes and hearts fixed on Him, not on our circumstances!
